    - 1. The people were required to bring a tithe to the Lord. Lev. 27:30-32
    - 2. The people were required to bring a second **tithe** for their **festivals**. Deuteronomy 12:10-11; 14:22-27
    - 3. Every three years they brought a **tithe** for the **poor**. Deut. 14:28-29
    - 4. There was also a temple/census "charge." Exodus 30:13
  - D. They also had **freewill** and **voluntary** offerings, even including **capital** campaigns for various projects, such as:
    - 1. The building of the **tabernacle**. Exodus 25:1-9; 35:4-36:7
    - 2. The building of the **temple**. 1 Chronicles 28-29
    - 3. The repairs of the temple under Kings Joash and Josiah 2 Kings 12:4-6; 22:3-7
    - 4. The **rebuilding of the altar/temple** under Kings Cyrus and Darius. Ezra/Neh.
  - E. The last book in the Old Testament, Malachi, includes a stern warning and a marvelous promise. Malachi 3:6-15
